SUMMARY

The development and conservation goals for Tikvara Nature Park in the planning period are:

- Monitoring the status of all natural values according to the defined conservation regime
- Active conservation of ecosystems, remediation and restoration of valuable habitats
- Harmonization of the permitted use of natural resources (forestry, game management, angling), balancing sport and tourism activities with the conservation and protection needs of the protected area, and development of sustainable development and wise use principles
- Complete activation of the tourism and recreation potential and development of special types of tourism in cooperation with the local communities
- Implementation of remediation and restoration measures aimed at maintaining spatial planning and technical conditions for the conservation of natural values with more of less pronounced changes caused by degradation
- Support to development of the fundamental functions of the protected area for the needs of scientific research, cultural, educational, informative, marketing, sport and

recreation, tourism and other activities in line with the sensitivity and capacity of the area, improving the promotion, presentation and popularization of Tikvara Nature Park

- Design of programmes, projects and studies that are conservation oriented, maintenance and the use of natural values and land with the elimination of possible negative influences to the protected area
- Increase the degree of technical equipping and human resources in the structures of the site manager entrusted with the conservation, development and maintenance of Tikvara Nature Park
