**LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR THE NOMINATION OF "BAČKO PODUNAVLJE"
UNESCO/MAB BIOSPHERE RESERVE**

Ministers responsible for environmental protection in Austria, Croatia, Hungary, Serbia and Slovenia signed in March 2011 a Ministerial Declaration to join their individual protected riverine areas and to establish a UNESCO Transboundary Biosphere Reserve to protect their shared nature and wildlife along the Mura, Drava and Danube rivers. This agreement was based on the initial initiative of Croatia and Hungary and a respective agreement signed in 2009.
